**Cost: \$4 per participant**

Students may participate in up to 3 individual events and each school may submit up to 3 participants in each individual event. Students may participate in a test above their grade level, but not below. Students will have 20 minutes for each test. However, as soon as students finish, they should turn in their answer sheet because ties will be broken according to submission times. Awards will be given for the top 5 places in each event.

**Calculators will not be allowed on the Arithmetic Skills, Fraction, Number Theory or Pre-Algebra tests.** Students should bring at least 2 sharpened pencils.

Each school may submit up to 2 teams consisting of **two to four** students in both the 5/6 grade and 7/8 grade team competitions. Each school is encouraged to bring at least 2 “helpers”.

Overall school awards will be calculated by:

7 points for each 1<sup>st</sup> place won in an individual event  
5 points for each 2<sup>nd</sup> place won in an individual event  
3 points for each 3<sup>rd</sup> place won in an individual event  
2 points for each 4<sup>th</sup> place won in an individual event  
1 point for each 5<sup>th</sup> place won in an individual event

20 points for each 1<sup>st</sup> place won in a team event  
15 points for each 2<sup>nd</sup> place won in a team event  
10 points for each 3<sup>rd</sup> place won in a team event
